

Simplice Asongu is the Lead Economist and Director of the African Governance and Development Institute (AGDI). He holds a PhD in Financial Development from Oxford Brookes University (UK). As a nonconformist economist, he has been promoting the African economics of self-reliance with the AGDI which by most standards of assessment is a leading institution in knowledge production for African development.

Dr. Asongu has received many international awards for scientific excellence and is currently embarked on a mission of mentoring younger African scholars in contribution to knowledge for African development by means of scientific publications. He has a publication output of about 200 papers that are published and forthcoming in leading international journals. He acts as a referee for over 70 academic journals and research consortiums and is on the editorial board of many journals including the *Africagrowth Agenda*.

Dr. Asongu's research interests include: development models, financial development, knowledge economy and development economics. He supervises PhD and Master students in these fields.
